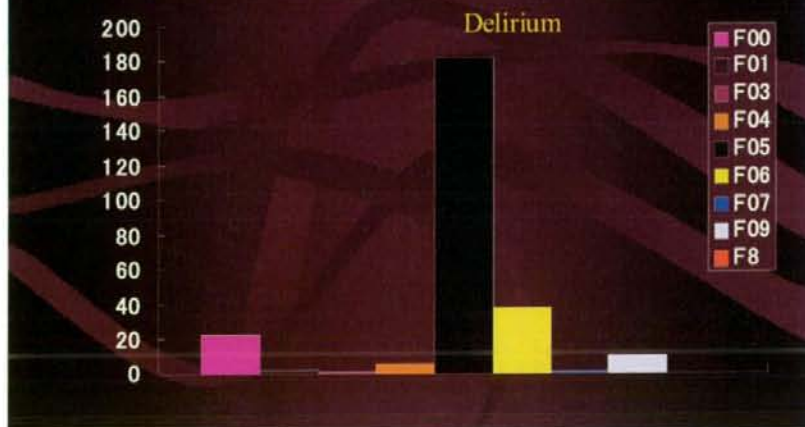

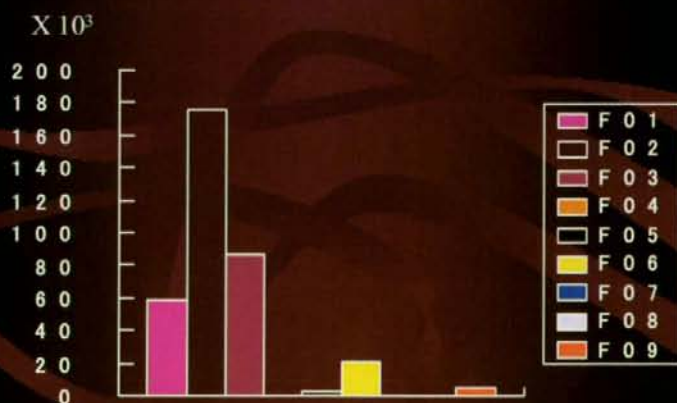

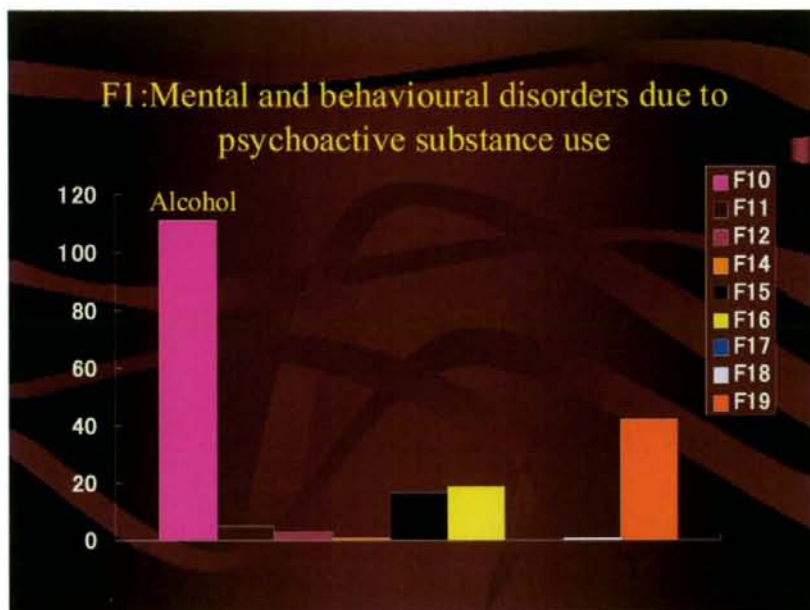


## Opinion (F00 – 09)

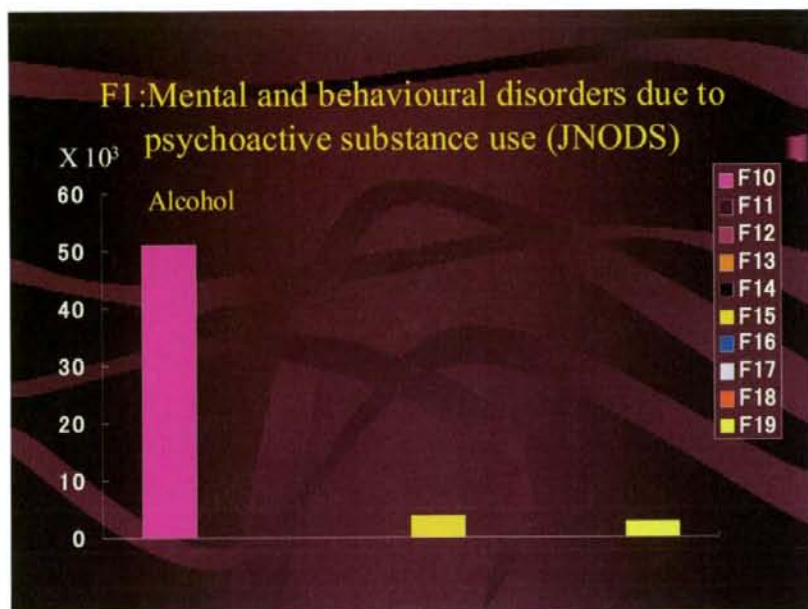

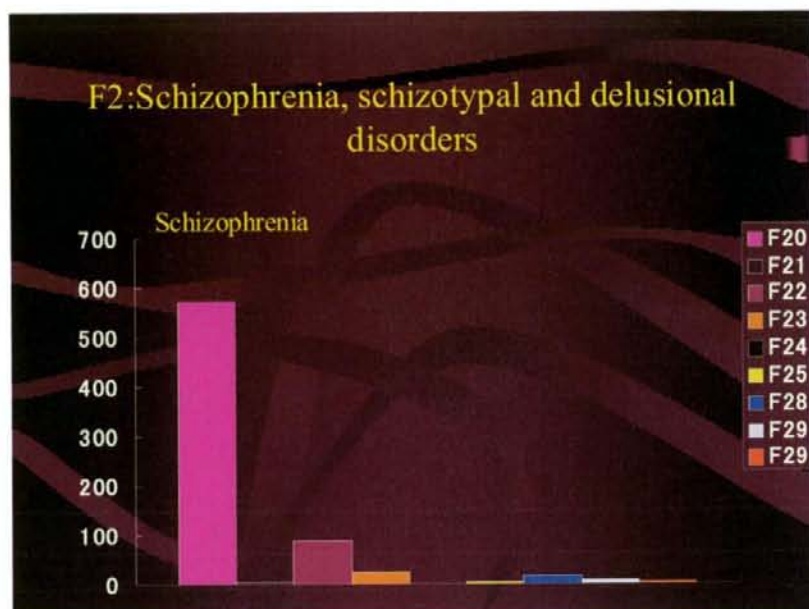

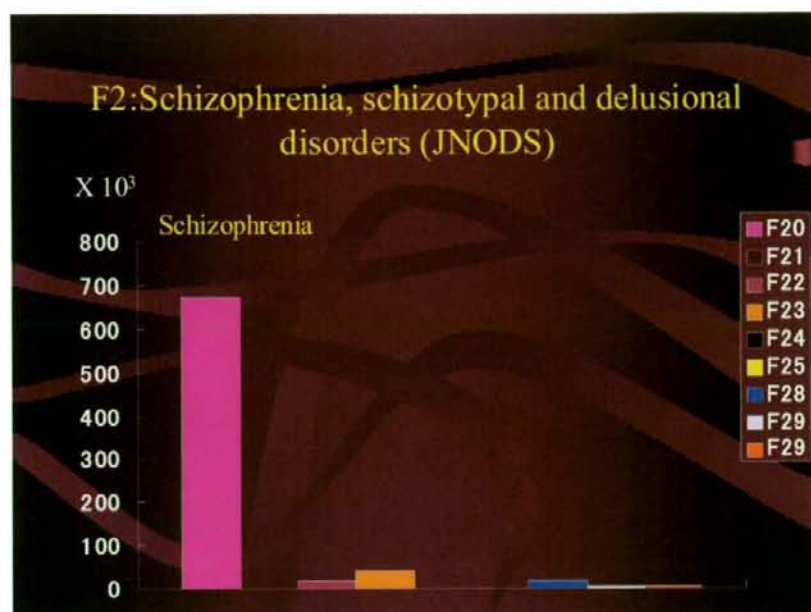

**Post-schizophrenic depression  
(Postpsychotic depressive disorder of Schizophrenia)**

It is not clear how to define symptom and how to distinguish it from the residual phase of Schizophrenia and Schizoaffective disorder.

**Simple schizophrenia**

It is premature to consider it as an official category.

**Schizotypal disorder**

It is not clear that Schizotypal disorder belongs to schizophrenia-related disorders or personality disorder.

**Acute and transient psychotic disorder**

Further research is necessary to distinguish other Intermediate(Third) psychoses such as schizoaffective disorder, cycloid psychosis and so forth.

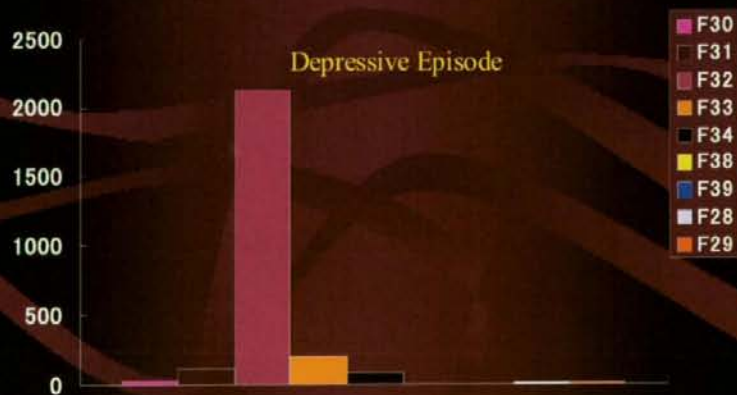

- Clarify these relationship on diagnostic criteria



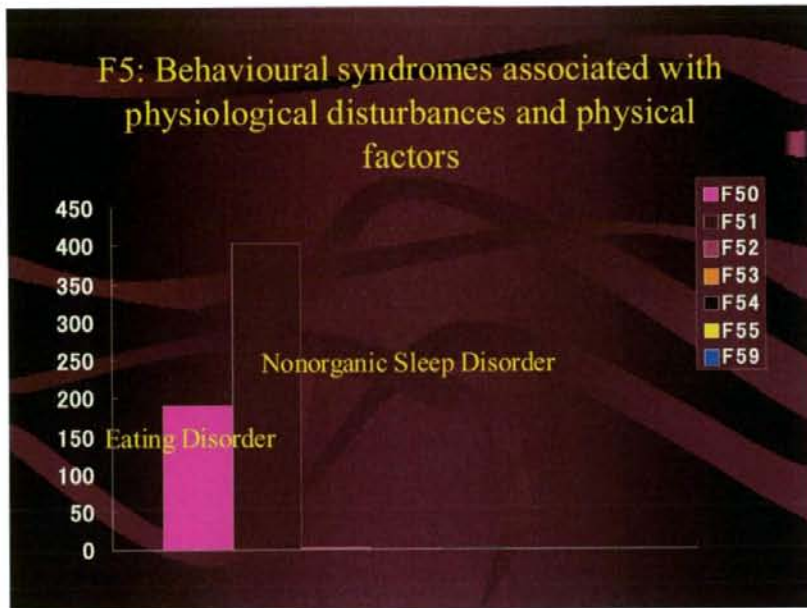
## Opinion (F40 – 49)

- Should be reconsidered;
  - F48.0 Neurasthenia (only 6 out of about 8,000 cases, but common in China)
- Include 5-character diagnosis
  - F43.1 Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
  - F43.11 compensatory type
  - F43.12 non compensatory type
- Change nomenclature
  - F44.81 Multiple personality disorder

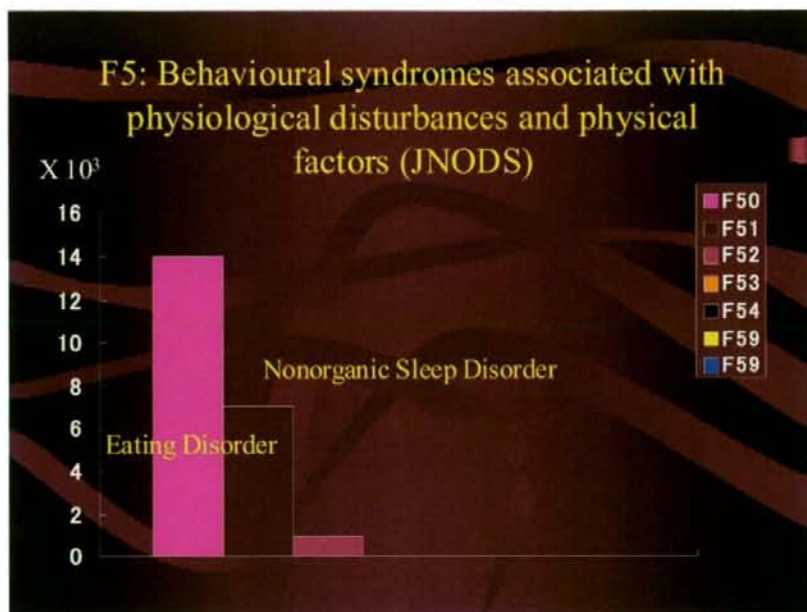

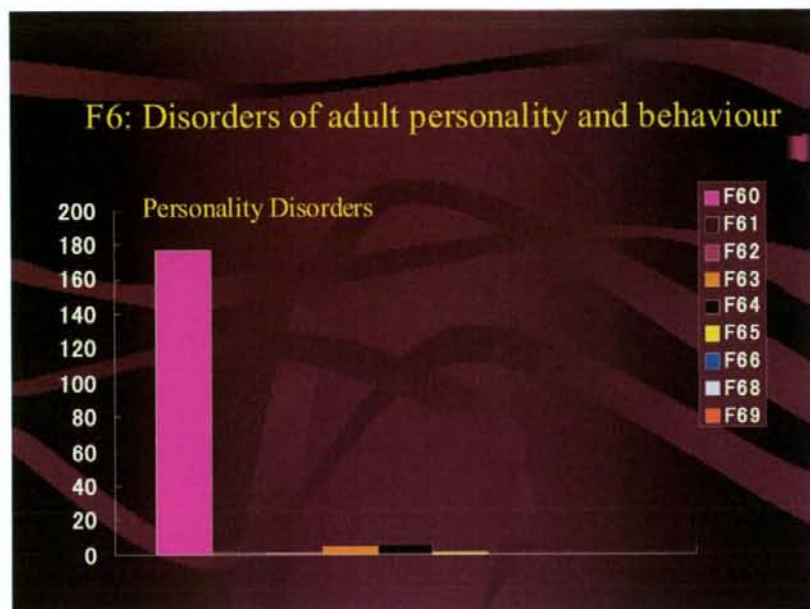

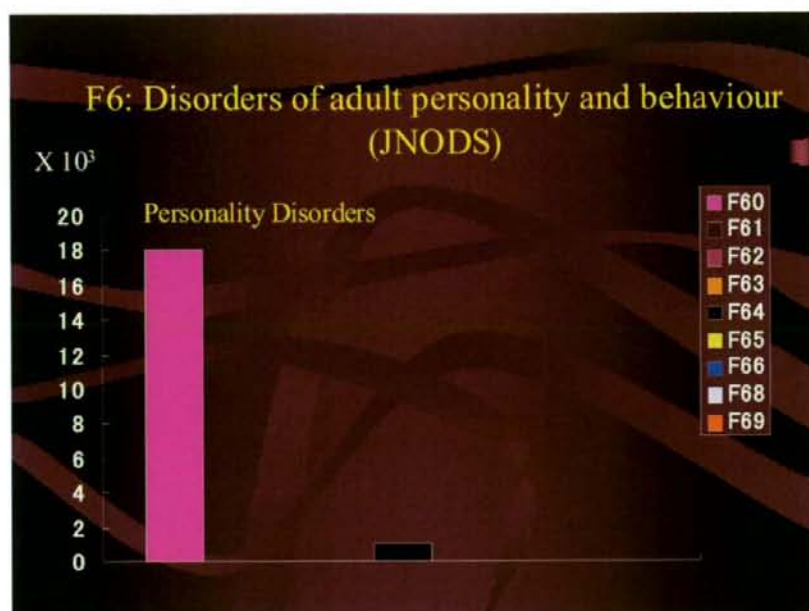
