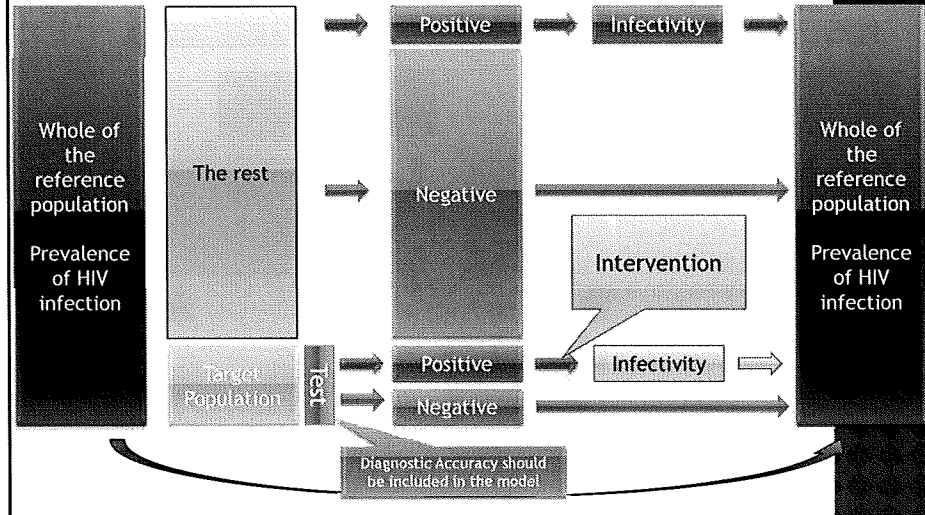


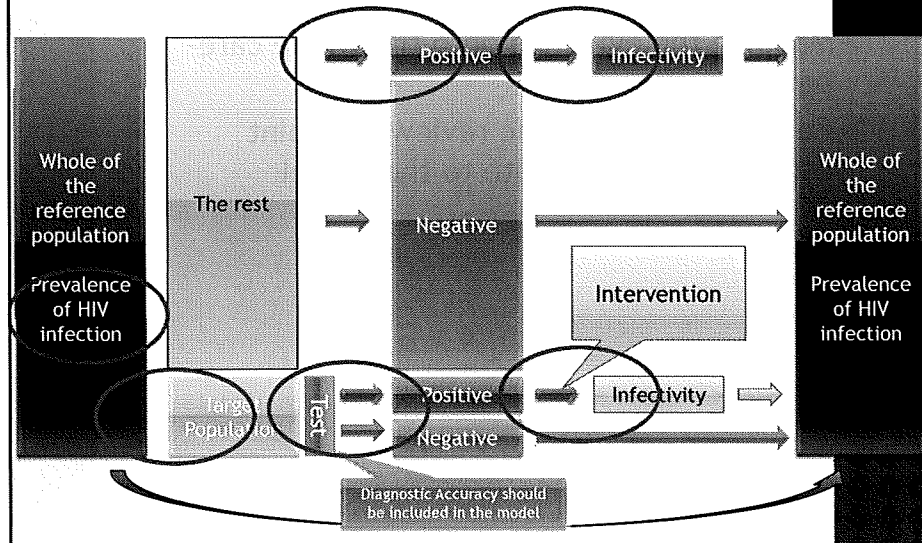

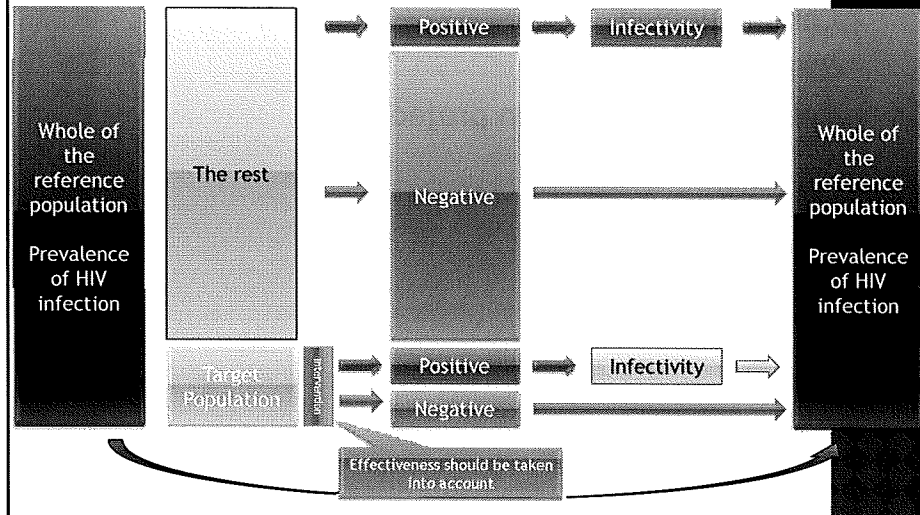
## WHOLE CARE-PATHWAY E.G. PMTCT/TB SCREENING



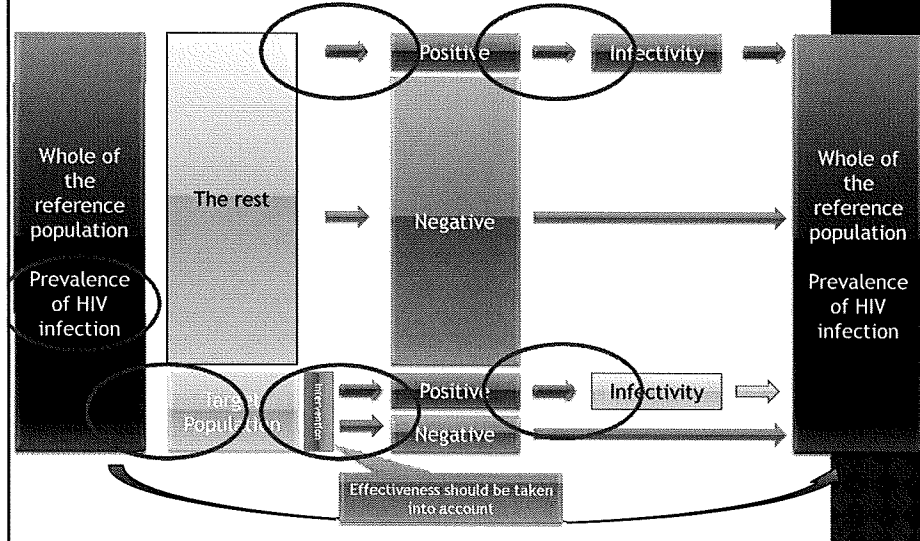
