






Key Requirements for CCC

- Good health pre-crisis secondary data including sub-national (e.g. district) level profiles;
- Quality health assessments completed in a timely manner at the beginning of a crisis;
- An appropriate early warning and response system for epidemic-prone diseases and Nutrition;
- An appropriate health monitoring/surveillance system that provides regular data on mortality, morbidity, injury treatment and rehabilitation, potential health risks, and health service performance;


















Lessons learned

- Early Warning and Reponses System (EWARS) is needed;
- Consensus on a short list of priority conditions to be monitored, corresponding syndrome-based definitions;
- Consensus on a standard reporting format;
- · Building on existing early warning systems;
- · Reliable and rapid means of communication is key;
- Information should be gathered from a wide range of sources including the news-media, and informal sources, such as Health Map and Social Network System;
