

## Guest Observers: Japanese Society of Fertility Preservation (JSFP)

**Date of Visit:**

Monday January 8<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018

**Purpose of Visit:**

Investigate how Cincinnati Children's Hospital & Medical Center's Physicians and Comprehensive Fertility Care and Preservation Program provide information regarding fertility preservation to children and adolescents, and how CCHMC obtains informed assents from pediatric and adolescent patients. The observer's purpose is to use this information to create new informed assent tools which are suitable for use in Japan.

**Areas of Interest:**

- How CCHMC provides CAYA cancer patients with information regarding cancer diagnosis, cancer treatment and the risk of gonadal dysfunction/future infertility due to cancer treatment.
- How CCHMC provides CAYA cancer patients with supportive psychological care in regards to fertility preservation.

**Requested Observations:**

- Observe the site at CCHMC where informed assents and fertility preservation decision making aid are provided to pediatric patients and their families.
- Interview the Comprehensive Fertility Care and Preservation team at CCHMC about how they provide fertility preservation information, and how educational tools are used in this process.
- Have a discussion with the Comprehensive Fertility Care & Preservation Team at CCHMC about informed assents for fertility preservation, how fertility preservation decision making aids are made, etc.
