



Diagnosis

Primary symptoms (3 symptoms)

1. Microcephaly Head circumference is less than 3% of the average for gender and age.
2. High-level proteinuria(urine protein/creatinine ratio ≥ 1.0 g/gCr, or daily urine protein ≥ 1 g) for which steroids are not effective or steroids are predicted not to be effective
3. Facial dysmorphism (auricles, etc.)
Abnormal ears such as large and floppy ears, ears rotated backward, low-set ears, and other facial dysmorphism (narrow forehead, small jaw, high palate, wide-set eyes, etc.)
